- 'Active duty members of the Armed Services of the United States residing in this state and their spouses and dependent children, and a members of the Florida National Guard. (Required: Copy of military orders or DD2058 showing home of record.)
- Active duty members of the Armed Services of the United States and their spouses and dependents attending a Florida College System or state university within 50 miles of the military establishment where they are stationed, if such military establishment is within a county Florida. (Required: Copy of military orders)
- ¹ United States citizens living on the Isthmus of Panama, who have completed 12 consecutive months of college work at the Florida State Panama Canal Branch, and their spouses and dependent children. (Required: Copy of marriage certicate or proof of dependency.)
- Full-time instructional and administrative personnel employed by state public schools and institutions of higher education and their spot dependent children.
- Students from Latin America and the Caribbean who receive scholarships from the federal or state government. Any student classi ed public paragraph shall attend, on a full-time basis, a Florida institution of higher education. (Required: proof of scholarship and Latin America residency.)
- Southern Regional Education Board's Academic Common Market graduate students attending Florida's state universities. (Required: Cletter from State Academic Common Market Coordinator.)
- Full-time employees of state agencies or political subdivisions of the state when the student fees are paid by the state agency or political subdivision for the purpose of job-related law enforcement or corrections training.
- 'McKnight Doctoral Fellows and Finalists who are United States citizens. (Required: Veri cation from graduate studies.)
- ¹ United States citizens living outside the United States who are teaching at a Department of Defense Dependent School or in an Americ International School and who enroll in a graduate level education program which leads to a Florida teaching certi cate.
- Active duty members of the Canadian military residing or stationed in this state under the North American Air Defense (NORAD) agreer their spouses and dependent children, attending a Florida College System institution or state university within 50 miles of the military es where they are stationed. (Required: proof of active duty membership for speci ed purpose.)
- Active 'duty members of a foreign nation's military who are serving as liaison of cers and are residing or stationed in this state, and their spouses and dependent children, attending a Florida College System or state university within 50 miles of the military establishment whiliaison of cer is stationed. (Required: proof of active duty membership for speci ed purpose.)
