- Finally, our School joined forces with USF's Muma College of Business to design and deliver a series of highly successful (and intense!) two- and four-day *Cybersecurity for Executives* that included senior leaders from a number of government agencies and jurisdictions (such as U.S. Central Command, Hillsborough County, and the Tampa Aviation and Port Authorities), as well as a host of private companies.
