

The CAS Tenure and Promotion Committee was comprised of nine professors representing the three "schools" within the USF College of Arts and Sciences (School of Humanities, School of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, and School of Social Sciences). The committee was convened on Oct. 29, 2018. As the first item of business, the committee elected a chair.

The committee focused its attentions on four issues: what was the department's stated criteria for tenure and promotion; what did the mid-tenure evaluation state, did the candidate meet the criteria of excellence in instruction, service, and research as stipulated in the department tenure and promotion guidelines, and how strong were the candidate's outside letter of support. Attention was given to excellence in instruction and service. Great scrutiny was given to the productivity of the candidate's research.

The committee reviewed 25 candidates for tenure and promotion and seven candidates for promotion. These applications were forwarded to the Office of the Dean of CAS on December 2, 2018.

The committee was reconvened on April 4, 2019 to review nine mid-tenure applications. The committee expects to conclude its work for the 2018-19 academic year on April 29, 2019.
