Understanding the Assignment

Read the prompt carefully. Identify the topic, the question, and the requirements. Underline key words and phrases.

Identify the main idea and the supporting points.

Brainstorm ideas. Use mind maps or lists to organize your thoughts. Consider different perspectives and evidence.

Choose a thesis statement. It should be clear, concise, and arguable. It should state your main argument and the direction of your essay.

Develop an outline. Organize your ideas into a logical sequence. Use topic sentences to introduce each paragraph.
